The award was made in recognition of the design work for the U.S. 40 Pedestrian Bridge over White Lick Creek in Plainfield. It was envisioned as a signature structure of the city's trail system and provided a link from the downtown to the Greenways Trail and a future sports complex on the west side of the creek.

Only one Grand Project Award is made each year by ACEC Indiana to recognize an outstanding engineering achievement that demonstrates a high degree of merit and ingenuity.

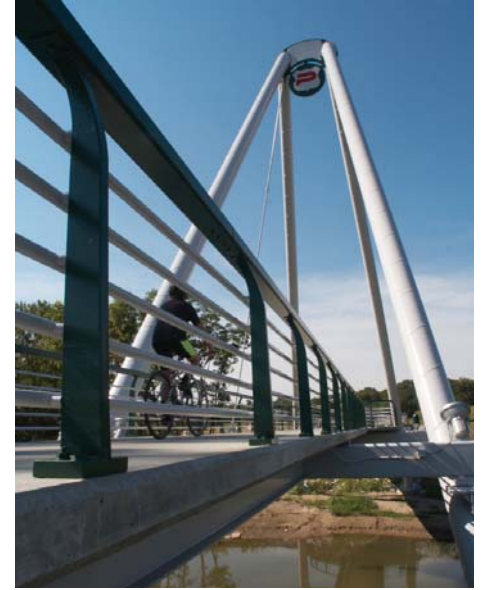
ACEC Indiana President Ross Snider,
