2nd Annual Environmental Business Conference with IDEM

On September 14, 2006, ACEC Indiana will offer its second annual Environmental Business Conference with the Indiana Department of Environmental Management on "The State of the Environmental Engineering Profession in Indiana."

With limited budgets for capital improvements, communities are being asked to address new drinking water regulations, control storm water runoff, eliminate combined and sanitary sewer overflows as well as general infrastructure. Attendees will gain beneficial information on these concerns and earn five PDH's towards license renewal certification.

Professionals from IDEM and the regulated community will come together to present critical information on all three sectors: water, air, and land.
