Topics that will be presented are:

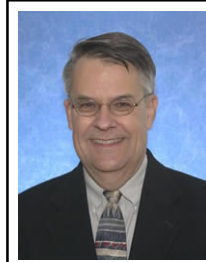
- * *Regulatory updates on water concerns and CSO Policy, with panel discussion*
