INDOT Commissioner Browning Shares Views with ACEC

Karl Browning, Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Transportation, addressed the membership of ACEC Indiana at its luncheon in May.

Kicking off his remarks, he emphasized that INDOT and the professional consulting engineering firms needed to work together to ensure timely delivery of the transportation program.

Speaking candidly, he spoke on a number of important topics including: the increased workload associated with Major Moves, Local Public Agency (LPA) federal aid

projects (including Transportation Enhancement projects), the backlog of audits, the RFP process and his goal to reduce the time between contract award and notice-to-proceed, plans to improve the posting of scores, the selection process, the estimating system, close-out of contracts, quality of delivery, utility relocations, the PDP and Cultural Resource manuals, and more.

Browning reviewed recent organizational and staff changes to work more efficiently and effectively. Gil Viets, Chief of Staff, and



Mike Cline, Deputy Commissioner of Traffic Management, also attended the luncheon.

In closing, the Commissioner stressed the Department's goal to improve its quality and timeliness of the design process because it has a more aggressive construction schedule, and to become more business friendly.
